## Day 1 Arrival

Arrival in Quimper. After check-in you can discover this beautiful city with its impressive cathedral and its interesting architecture.

## Day 2 Quimper - Pont Aven 43 km

You leave Quimper with its tiny medieval streets to cycle through the Breton back country. You reach Pont Aven, a small village which was an important center of the impressionism movement and welcomes artists like Paul Gauguin. Enjoy a stroll and spass at one of the numerous galleries.



## Day 3 Pont Aven - Concarneau 43 km

You leave Pont Aven and its beautiful harbor. After a hilly part you reach typical picturesque villages. You follow the coast on little roads. Here you can enjoy the beautiful view. You reach Concarneau with its "Ville Close", the fortified city, which is an ancient monastery. You can have a walk on the city wall and enjoy the nice view on the harbor and the surrounding of Concarneau.

## Day 4 Concarneau - Bénodet 35 km

Today some climbs are waiting you. But you will be rewarded with a fabulous landscape, with parts directly next to the sea, almost untouched beaches, and beautiful Breton churches. Destination of the trip is the sea resort and spa town Bénodet. We propose to go to the beautiful sandy beach for a swim.



## Day 5 Bénodet - Penmarch 44 km

You leave the hotel by bike along the coast passing by Ile Toudy. From Ile Toudy you take a boat which goes to Locudy. Afterwards you cycle through picturesque villages, before you get to the coastal bike path where you can enjoy the breathtaking view on the sea and the beaches. The lighthouse of Penmarc'h, Phare Eckmühl, is one of the highest lighthouses of France. So, let's go! There are only 307 steps to the top of the 65 m high tower.

## Day 6 Penmarch - Pointe du Raz 63 km

From one headland to another. From Penmarc'h you are cycling to the most western part of France, the Pointe du Raz. Mostly on little routes and the sea always in sighting distance with its large beaches, you arrive in Audierne. This little town is known for its fish canning industry. Afterwards you reach the impressive cap.

## Day 7 Pointe du Raz - Quimper 59 km

You are passing through Douarnenez, which is known for its important fishing harbor with awesome boats. The path leads you again to the heartland towards Quimper. You are cycling through forests and along meadows. You have the possibility to stop in Locronan, one of the most beautiful villages in France. The trip ends in the capital of Cornouaille, Quimper.

After the breakfast it is time to say "Au revoir et à bientôt"
