

NORTHWEST SARDINIA | CLASSIC

The northwest of Sardinia is an ideal region to discover by bike, between turquoise sea and wild mountains. From the charming town of Alghero with its Catalan heritage to the majestic Capo Caccia, the landscapes are breathtaking. Cycling takes you past secret beaches, impressive cliffs and picturesque villages like Bosa with its colorful houses. Every detour has a new surprise in store, be it a magnificent view or local culinary treasures. This bike tour immerses you in the authenticity and beauty of Sardinia and offers you an unforgettable adventure.

Day 1 Arrival in Alghero

Individual arrival to Alghero. Check-in, bicycle collection and handover of travel documents.

Day 2 Capo Caccia (circular route) 54 km

You start at the old fortifications and the charming historic center of Alghero. After the prehistoric bastion of Nuraghe Palmavera, you'll reach Capo Caccia, an imposing 168-m-high rocky outcrop overlooking the sea, and back to Alghero you'll walk through a landscape of vineyards and olive groves that produce world-famous oils and wines.

Day 3 Alghero - Bosa 44 km

Cycle along a scenic coastal road over the cliffs overlooking the sea and admire the views of the Gulf of Alghero and Capo Caccia. Emotions continue when you catch a glimpse of the pink, red and gray cliffs of Capo Marargiu. Her day ends in Bosa, a medieval town known for its fine embroidery and gold filigree work.

Day 4 Bosa (circular route) 26/62 km

The short stage winds through the vineyards along the Malvasia Wine Route, with tasting of these famous DOC wines in the various wine cellars. The long stage is a circular route through the area where the grifons nest, up to the Montresta and past the Nuraghe Appiu to the spectacular rocky outcrops and coves of Capo Marrargiu, where with a bit of luck you can watch the swoop of this rare species of Mediterranean vulture.





Day 5 Bosa - Santu Lussurgiu 55 km

The current route goes through vineyards and olive groves as far as Flussio and Tinnura, two small localities known for their baskets of reeds and willows and their murals (mural paintings). We continue through the pastures of Sagama, where the Mediterranean bush landscape stretches as far as the eye can see until you reach the springs of San Leonardo, the most water-rich area in Sardinia.

Day 6 Santa Cristina (circular route) 39 km

Visit the Agricultural Museum in Santulussurgiu and cycle to the archaeological site of Santa Cristina to admire the impressive holy well built in 1800 BC.



Day 7 Santu Lussurgiu - Cabras 54

Today the land slopes down to the coast and leads to the Sinis Marine Reserve, home to pink flamingos and herons. Here we take a dirt road that runs along a series of white quartz beaches. We then continue through a charming fishing village home to one of Sardinia's most important early Christian churches and on to Tharros, a fascinating coastal archaeological site with an abundance of Phoenician and Roman remains.

Day 8 departure

After breakfast your cycling holiday is over.
