### Day 1 Arrival in Reims

Your cycling vacation begins in Reims. After arrival, you will have the opportunity to visit this beautiful city. You can get in the mood for the weekend ahead with your first glass of champagne or enjoy your first tasting right away.



### Day 3 Epernay - Côte des Blancs - Epernay 35 km

Today, the route takes you through several charming wine villages. Most of them bear the designation Blanc de Blanc. The landmark is very typical of Champagne. Tasting of the "Blanc de Blanc." Easy bike ride back to Epernay.


### Day 4 Epernay - Hautvillers - Epernay 45 km

Starting from Épernay, this bike ride takes the form of a pleasant loop through the heart of the Champagne vineyards. The route takes you through the region's rolling countryside to the charming village of Hautvillers, the birthplace of champagne. With vineyards stretching as far as the eye can see, picturesque villages, and stunning views of the Marne Valley, this outing offers a wonderful immersion into the soul of Champagne.

### Day 2 Reims - Epernay 42 km

You leave Reims on the quiet towpath along the Aisne-Marne Canal. Then you leave the canal and cycle through the hilly landscape of vineyards. In the wine-growing village of Chigny-les-Roses, you should definitely stop off—there are 41 wine cellars here that invite you to taste their wines. The route continues through the vineyards. In Ludes, you can enjoy a tasting at Canard Duchesne. The day's stage ends in Epernay, where you can explore the Avenue de Champagne.
